

**Melrose Business and Community Association  
General Meeting Minutes-October 12, 2011**

The meeting was called to order by Tom Lucas at 11:45 am. There were approximately 23 members and guest present. Invocation was given and followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Melrose Alert- We have begun to re-distribute the Melrose Alert monthly to local businesses to help generate interest. Also handouts on the Plum Creek development were provided for those who were interested.

Moring. The floor was open for nominations, and none was received. Ballot was voted on and all nominated officers and directors were voted into office.

Farmer's Market- Ed Sherwood that music will start this week during the Farmer's Market. Also the Merry Melrose 11<sup>th</sup> annual craft festival and parade will be on 12/10/11. Also the 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Monarch festival was in September at the Greenhouse Butterfly Farm and went well and they are planning for the festival again next year.

Shake Rag- June Beverly reported the Aztec Dancers will be at Shake Rag outside dancing on 12/10/11 at 1:00pm.

Alachua County Sheriff Office – Leo Lowe reported there is still cooper theft going on in the area. Also he reminded everyone to make sure they call if they have an incident or see something suspicious. If you call the non-emergency number you will be anonymous. By reporting incidents you will get more patrolling in the area. Also Leo wants to do a Crime watch meeting in January to train the community; this should be about an hour long.
