- Merry Melrose DOES NOT provide anything for your booth – ONLY THE SPACE. No stakes or other objects are allowed to penetrate the ground in the park.
- Vendors understand that the Merry Melrose Arts & Crafts Festival, Heritage Park nor the Melrose Business Community Association is not responsible for vendor or vendor goods prior to, during, or after the festival.
- The Merry Melrose Festival Manager reserves the right to remove any vendor or work that it considers to be in bad or questionable taste. **PLEASE REMEMBER THIS IS A FAMILY ORIENTED EVENT**
- Vendor is responsible for maintaining the space and leaving it clean. Please use the trash cans available. Heritage Park is a community park. It is everyone's responsibility to keep it clean.
